Meeting Venues

All meetings, with the exception of certain committee meetings, will take place at the Ecumenical Centre. Members will be informed of arrangements made for the committee meetings at a later date.

Accommodation

Local Transportation

The Hotel Ramada Park has a complimentary shuttle bus running every 20 minutes between the airport and hotel. The bus picks up guests at the bus stop located just outside the arrival hall.

During the central committee sessions at the Ecumenical Centre a shuttle bus service will be provided by the WCC – please check the notice boards at the hotel and/or the Ecumenical Centre for the timetable.

Travel – arrival and departure dates

Please plan to arrive the day before your first meeting and depart on 2 September after 16.00 or on 3 September.

The Executive Committee meetings will take place prior to the central committee meeting on 24 and 25 August and therefore it is suggested that members arrive on 23 August.

Visas

Please check locally if you will require a visa for travel to and/or entry in Switzerland. Please note that <u>Switzerland is now part of the Schengen agreement</u> and thus an entry into Switzerland now requires either a Swiss entry visa or a Schengen visa. A letter of invitation to facilitate the visa(s) application(s) will be sent to you by separate post in the coming weeks. Please apply for your visa <u>immediately</u> assuring that your passport is valid for at least 6 months after your planned departure date from Switzerland.

Subsidised participants – Travel proposals

Travel proposals will be sent to members whose travel is usually arranged by the WCC (based on the 2008 Central Committee Meeting), or upon request. Subsidised members who usually arrange their own travel are reminded that the WCC can only reimburse <u>reasonably priced economy fare</u> tickets, based upon receipt of the ticket invoice.

Please note that the WCC cannot arrange special routing / dates that do not correspond to the meeting dates, and that tickets purchased for participants by the WCC cannot be changed at a later date.
