1958-2008: FIFTY YEARS AT THE SERVICE OF THE WCC An overview of Orthodox Staff

1. Introduction

The Executive Committee of the WCC, meeting in Lübeck, Germany (September 2008) has suggested "to carry out an inventory and analysis on how many of the WCC former staff have gone back to work with their churches or ecumenical organizations and to report to the next executive committee meeting". Having dealt with Orthodox participation in the WCC from several perspectives and being one of the old timers and thus having the privilege of knowing most of the Orthodox who served the Council, I have compiled this brief document with the hope that it will meet the expectations of the executive committee. I am convinced that from a practical point of view it will be easier to look at former WCC staff from regional and/or confessional perspective, rather than as a whole.

In 1958, ten years after the inaugural assembly of the WCC in Amsterdam, Dr Nikos Nissiotis, from the Church of Greece, was hired as lecturer at the Ecumenical Institute of Bossey. He was the first person from the Orthodox family to serve on the staff of the World Council of Churches.¹

Today, after fifty years, we could count a considerable number of representatives of Eastern and Oriental Orthodox Churches² who served in various capacities several units and departments of the Council.

The aim of the present survey is threefold: (a) to offer an overview to governing body members as they study ways of assessing staffing matters and sharpening staff policies; (b) to draw some learnings from 50 years of history; (c) to celebrate -- and express gratitude to -- those who served the Council, knowing that some of them are not with us anymore.

Looking carefully at the analytical presentation of the figures, two preliminary conclusions could be drawn:

(a) The great majority of the Orthodox staff members clearly represented their churches and, therefore, after their period of service in the WCC they have

occupied high positions both within their own church and the ecumenical movement;

(b) Participation of youth and women has been rather weak; it is mainly because of the internship programme of the Council that there has been a certain increase in the number of youth and women.
